



## UNIFIED DATA FETCH SERVICES SUPPLEMENT

- 1. Definitions.** Any capitalized term not defined in this Unified Data Fetch Services Supplement (“Supplement”) will have the meaning set forth in the Agreement.
  - 1.1 “Cloud Storage Provider” means the entity that provides the Cloud Storage Target.
  - 1.2 “Cloud Storage Target” means the cloud storage resource controlled by data.ai and allocated for Customer’s use hereunder.
  - 1.3 “Cloud Storage Target Region” means the region (as designated by the Cloud Storage Provider) in which the Cloud Storage Target is located.
  - 1.4 “Documentation” means any user documentation made available by data.ai to Customer that describe the UDF Services.
  - 1.5 “Estimates” mean the mobile market estimates provided to Customer via the data.ai Intelligence Services subscribed to by Customer as set forth in an Order Form and that are made available to Customer via the UDF Services.
  - 1.6 “Fetch” means the transfer of Estimates by data.ai to the Cloud Storage Target designated for Customer’s use as part of the UDF Services.
  - 1.7 “Order Form” means an ordering document for the UDF Services that incorporates this Supplement by reference and is entered into by the parties.
  - 1.8 “UDF Services” means the “Unified Data Fetch” service(s) listed in an Order Form, which Fetch Estimates to data.ai’s Cloud Storage Targets as further described herein and the Documentation, and are considered “Services” for purposes of the Agreement.
  
- 2. Usage Rights, Provisioning, Availability.**
  - 2.1 As set forth in the Order Form and Documentation, data.ai will push Estimates to the Cloud Storage Target for use by Customer. All rights, restrictions, and limitations applicable to the Services and Estimates (and Customer’s access to and use thereof) remain as set forth in the Agreement.
  - 2.2 data.ai shall provide to Customer the documentation necessary for Customer to access the Cloud Storage Target, including the Cloud Storage Provider, Cloud Storage Target Region, Cloud Storage Target identifier, API endpoint to retrieve connection credentials, and number of years of Estimates to be made available via the UDF Services (which will not exceed Customer’s Intelligence Services entitlement).
  - 2.3 Customer acknowledges that some Estimates included in the data.ai Intelligence web portal may not be available for Fetch via the UDF Services.
  - 2.4 Customer acknowledges that the Estimates that are provided to the Cloud Storage Target will be removed 30 days from the time of successful delivery. In the event that the Customer’s subscription to any Estimates expires, those Estimates will be removed from the Cloud Storage Target upon such expiration.
  
- 3. Cloud Storage Target Access and Use.**

data.ai will maintain a subscription to and configure the Cloud Storage Target to receive Estimates via Fetch hereunder. Customer’s access to and use of the Cloud Storage Target is subject to the standard terms and conditions of the Cloud Storage Provider, and Customer shall comply with all such terms and conditions (including acceptable use and similar policies), which may be found via the “Legal” link (or similar link) on the Cloud Storage Provider’s website. data.ai does not license, support, control, endorse or otherwise make any representations or warranties regarding, and shall have no liability associated with, the Cloud Storage Target or the Estimates’ suitability for use on the Cloud Storage Target. The UDF Services are not necessary or required for use of the data.ai Intelligence Services.
  
- 4. Cloud Storage Target Data Egress**

Customer acknowledges that any egress of the Estimates from the Cloud Storage Target to another IT resource may result in the assessment of egress, transfer, transmission, or similar fees from the Cloud Storage Provider, ISPs, providers, and/or other IT resource providers (such as the the provider of the resource to which Customer elects to transmit the Estimates), and Customer is solely responsible for the payment of any such fees (and will reimburse data.ai for any such fees paid on Customer’s behalf by data.ai). Specifically, Customer acknowledges that transfer of Estimates from the Cloud Storage Target to another Cloud Storage Provider or to a different region may incur additional fees, and Customer is solely responsible for the payment of any such fees. Notwithstanding the foregoing, data.ai will not charge Customer for the transfer of Estimates within the same Cloud Storage Target Region administered by the same Cloud Storage Provider at no additional cost.
